Lafayette Football Booster Meeting

April 10, 2018

- Meeting called to order by Dana Bradford @ 06:34 pm
- Board members present: Dana (President), Kacey (VP), Tom (Treasurer), Shanell (Secretary), Noreen (concessions), Annie (fundraising), Shirla, Sandy, and Melissa (class reps).

CAMPS

- Coach Shaw, our head coach spoke about recruiting
- Summer Football Camp fliers were handed out
- Coach Shaw asked that parents reach out to him to inquire about their son's athletic ability/development.
 - He will give you suggestions on what camps to attend
 - O He will give you advice on your son's athletic ability/development

He suggested:

- Athletes not attend combines unless they are seasoned and have the appropriate skill set, because to recruiters the first impression means everything!
- O Athletes not attend more than 4 camps
- Athletes not attend overnight camps
- O Athletes not attend the Rivals combine unless they have 2 or more offers (this is a combine where they are ranked and given stars)

• He recommended:

- Athletes to attend 1 day camps only
- Athletes attend mega camps because they have multiple recruiters there to observe
- Athletes to attend CKFS combine, UK camps, University of Ohio camp and University of Cincinnati
- Camps are good for development!
- Coach wants to do more 7 vs 7 camps to help with player development more information in the future.

RECRUITING

- Athletes cannot be approached for recruiting until Junior year
- Coach Shaw was opposed to parents/athletes paying for recruiting services. Why?
 - All college coaches have to go through him anyway
 - He has the exact same contact information for college coaches for free
 - o These services cost money!!!
- In order to be able to play in college you have to:
 - O Maintain a 2.3 or higher GPA

- Score at least an 18 on your ACT
 - Take the ACT multiple times to achieve a higher score which will increase chances of more scholarship money
- Coach wanted every parent to be mindful that D1 schools are not meant for everyone.
- Do not pressure your kids about recruitment, they need to focus, develop skills, and have fun while playing high school football.
- Coach wanted to remind parents/athletes that offers are not set in stone until the Letter of Intent/scholarship is signed and they are renewable on a yearly basis

HUDL ACCOUNTS

- DO NOT mess with your son's hudl highlights!!
 - o Coach Shaw will compile the highlights, why?
 - What parents/athletes think are highlights, college level coaches have a different opinion!
- Each player will be given their hudl account information in due time!

- Coach expects all players to be in attendance during summer practice
