

Minutes of Lafayette Football Booster Meeting

April 14, 2011

- **Banners** – Coach Hayden reported that we can investigate the possibility of getting the advertising banners printed at cost by the same company doing the senior picture banners. Last year we paid \$75-100 each (Instant Signs-Stephen Cassity). Coach will check on the new company's cost to print them.
- **Banners** – We will be sharing banner sales with the LHS girls and boys soccer team. We get 50% of banner space in the stadium, with 25% each for the two soccer teams.
- **Field House** - Coach Hayden would like to start fundraising to build a field house. He shared some ideas for earning money such as an "Athlete's Dance" and the sale of memorial/honorary bricks in the stadium.
- **Helmets** – On Thursday, April 21 at 6:30 in the LHS library there will be a meeting for all football parents to hear a representative of Zenith helmets speak. He will be sharing information on the effectiveness of this helmet in preventing concussions. Everyone needs to encourage/call/email as many football parents as possible to attend.
- **Fundraising** – Ideas shared: Kona Ice (shaved ice truck) at football games and possibly after school. Elite fundraising coupon card, Geno's tuxedo rental fundraiser (next year at prom season). We have volunteers working to set up a fundraiser at Comedy Off Broadway, hopefully sometime in May.
- **Concessions** – Several FCPS middle school football games will be held at LHS this fall. We will be splitting the concession stand duties with the soccer team. Right now we are in charge of concessions on Oct 20 and 27 (Thursdays).
- **Camps** – If you ever have questions about any camps you hear about, contact Coach Hayden. Some camps are combines (showcase for players) while others are skills camps.
 - NFL camp at Tates Creek HS. on June 13-17 from 6:30-8:30 p.m. each night. Coach Hayden wants the whole team to attend.
 - Football University Camp at Lafayette on June 3-5 (Friday 2-9 p, Sat 7a-5:30p, Sun 7a-5p)
 - CHAMP Camp – June 23-24 from 8a-4p each day at Lafayette. Emphasis on character building. Registration form is on website and was sent home with all players during spring practice.
- **Golf Scramble** – This fundraiser will be held on Saturday, June 18 at Golf Club of the Bluegrass in Nicholasville. Cost is \$65 per person or \$260 per foursome. Lunch is at 12:30 and included in the cost. Shotgun start will be at 1:30. We must have 90 players. We will also have a silent action in conjunction with this event.
- **HUDDLE program** - Coach Hayden would like to purchase an online program called "Huddle" that will facilitate sharing of game tapes amongst other schools and enable the coaching staff and players to analyze our own game tapes. It will cost \$1,400. Doug Carr made a motion to purchase it and Debbie Miller seconded the motion. Vote passed with all in favor.
