

## 7/10/13 Booster Meeting

Welcomed by Principal Jacobs. He announced Coach Shaw as our new head coach and expressed that he is excited about working with Coach Shaw.

Discussed farming out concessions on Friday evenings. Monday nights we will still do.

Angie Alstatt said that she was for this option as long as we raise enough \$ before season to do what we need to make sure the boys have the equipment they need to keep them safe on the field.

Sheree Nelson – Can we afford? She was against doing this because she is afraid that we will be giving up too much money.

Mike Bossert then stood up and explained the details of what is needed for the concession stand for benefit of the Basketball coaches.

Valerie Morrison – said that she was undecided

Jerry Hack asked about gate – Tasha said that if we decide to farm out the concessions to the girls basketball program then Jessie Clark will be allowed to collect gate funds to help their program.

Lashonda – is against. Afraid that we will not be able to make up these funds elsewhere.

Ernie Ellison – said that it is worth the cost to be able to see your kid play and that maybe we need to raise prices on our concessions.

There was much discussion about 20% of the people doing 80% of the work, also that we have been doing concessions for the 7 on 7 games and that was not counted in the projected budget for the coming year. We have 3 more still to come.

Mike Bossert made the motion:

“I make the motion that we farm out concessions to the Girls’ basketball team. They will help set up, man (12 people) and help clean up for 50% of profit.
